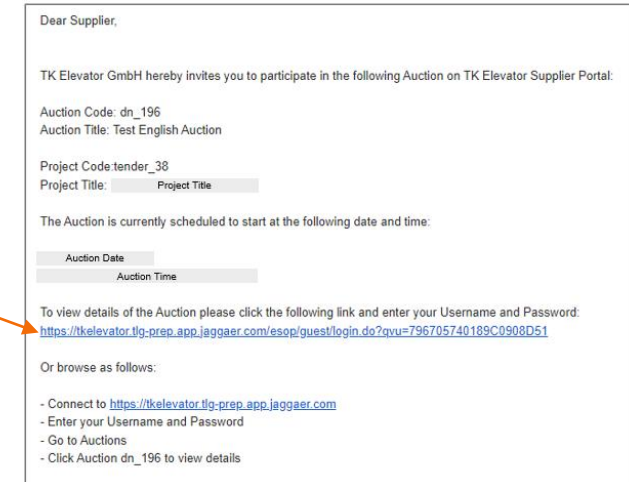
- This guide briefly explains how to participate in a so-called **English Auction**

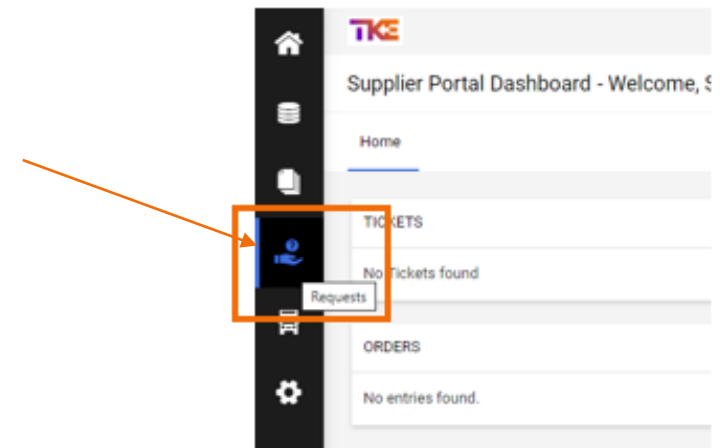
