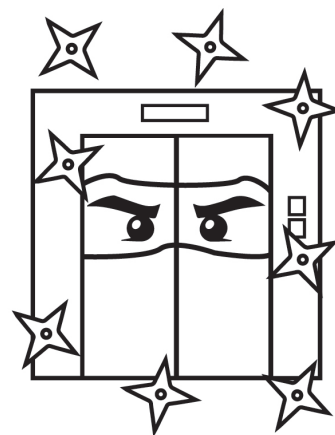
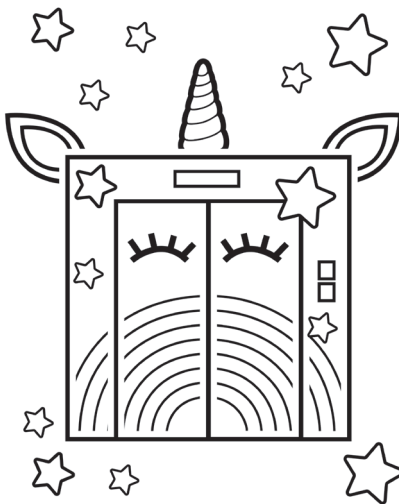
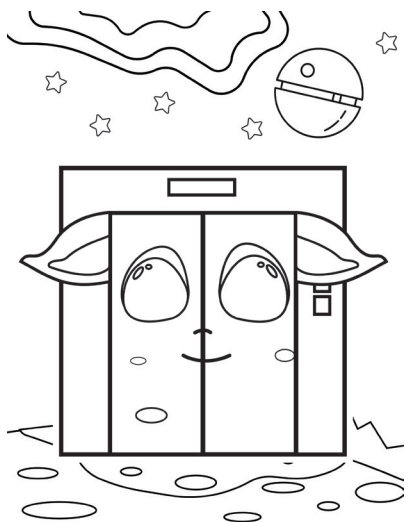
Everyone should be able to wear a Halloween costume - **EVEN AN ELEVATOR!**

SAFETY TIP!

HOW TO TRICK-OR-TREAT SAFELY

BEFORE YOU GO OUT FOR HALLOWEEN, CHECK OUT THESE TIPS SO YOU CAN HAVE A SAFE AND FUN TIME:

- Carry glow sticks or flashlights so drivers can see you better!
- Make sure you go trick-or-treating with a parent or adult.
- Watch for cars when crossing the street – and make sure you only cross the street at a corner or crosswalk.
- When you pick your costume, make sure it's not too long – you could trip or fall if it is!
- Ask an adult to paint your face instead of wearing a mask – a mask can make it harder for you to see.
